

The relative strengths and weaknesses of HERITAGE FINANCIAL CORP WA are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of HERITAGE FINANCIAL CORP WA compared to the market average is the variable Other Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 10% points. The greatest weakness of HERITAGE FINANCIAL CORP WA is the variable Deposits, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 8.7%, being 1.3% points below the market average of 10.0%.
