



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Renesas Electronics America Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Renesas Electronics America Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 122% points. The greatest weakness of Renesas Electronics America Inc is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 421%, being 53% points below the market average of 474%.
